Summer Term Opportunities and Upcoming Events

As we approach the start of the summer term, we would like to take this opportunity to give all parents/carers advance notice of some of the events coming up over the next few weeks, and to update you on some key information.

Online Safety Parent/Carer Information Evening – Monday 6 March 5.15-6.45pm

As parents/carers you will be aware of the enormous pressure on young people to use and interact with various online forums. A large proportion of the issues that we deal with in school relate to online behaviours and social media, and we remind pupils regularly that they should not be engaging with social media platforms until they are aged 13 or over. We are delighted that we have been able to secure some training for our staff and a guidance session for parents/carers which will be delivered by the Warwickshire County Council's Cyber Crime Advisor. The session will be focused on how young people can be groomed and radicalised online. Information will be shared on the latest social media apps and gaming trends to be aware of, as well as an insight into the dark web, how groomers use social media to radicalise young people and help and support that is available. This will be an invaluable session to enable parents/carers to keep abreast of the most current trends, dangers and warning signs relating to young people online. Uniform Expectations

At Houlton we pride ourselves on our high expectations of pupils both in terms of conduct and appearance. We have started to notice a small number of pupils not wearing their uniform correctly. Could all parents/carers ensure that when pupils arrive back after half term that skirts are worn in accordance with our uniform policy **(on or below the knee)**, that make up is not worn visibly and that pupils are wearing the correct school shoes. Pupils not wearing uniform correctly after half term will be asked to change into school trousers/shoes that are kept on site and may lose the privilege to wear the skirt if this persists. If you are purchasing new uniform and your child chooses to wear the skirt, please ensure that it has room for growth as pupils will not be permitted to wear skirts that are above knee length.
